Pepper ‘Ace’                      50/70 days              Sweet bell type. Compact plant produces extra early. Harvest at 50 days green and 70 days red. Medium size, 3-4 lobed fruit. High yields and tolerant of blossom drop. Performs well in cool climates.



Pepper ‘Baron’                      68/80 days              Formerly ‘Red Beauty’. Sweet bell type. Harvest at 68 days green and 80 days red. Thick walled, for stuffing or baking. Large fruited, 4 x 3.5". Four-lobed. Reliable color.



Pepper ‘Carmen’                      75 days                      Corno di Toro, or Bull's Horn type. Sweet Italian frying pepper. 2.5" wide, 6" long. Fully red when ripe. Sweet flavor and high yield, suitable for containers. All American Selection.



Pepper ‘Carolina Reaper’              90-100 days              Hottest pepper known today! 1.6-2.2 million SHU! Plants grown 4’ tall and wide, each producing approximately 30 2-3” fruits. Fruity sweet flavor followed by molten lava heat. Wear gloves when handling any part of fruits when ripe.



Pepper 'Confetti'

75 days

Bell pepper with variegated foliage produces mini 2-oz fruit that ripens from green to yellow and red. Thin-walled fruit. Best for containers and small spaces with or without support.



Pepper 'Early Summer'

68-73 days

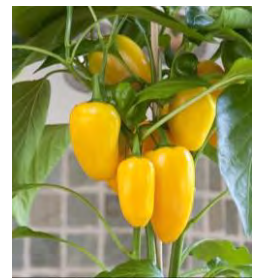
Bell pepper. Strong plants produce big harvests of extra-large yellow peppers with thick walls and uniform blocky shape. Excellent disease resistance.



Pepper 'Fresh Bites'

75-80 days

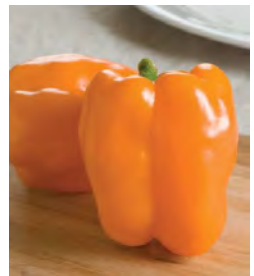
Sweet snacking type. Available in red, orange, and yellow. Compact plant reaches 18-24" and is excellent in containers. Small, sweet, thick-walled fruit, 2.5" x 1.5", adaptable to slightly dryer conditions.



Pepper 'Gourmet'

65/85 days

Sweet bell type. Bright orange fruit. Compact plant. Harvest at 65 days green and 85 days orange. Medium-large fruit with thick walls and juicy flavor. Easy to grow.



Pepper Greek Pepperoncini

65 days

Heirloom. Mild, sweet flavor is slightly hot. Bright green fruit, 1" x 4". Good fresh or for pickling with a crunchy texture.



Pepper 'Felicity'

65/85 days

Jalapeno type, with No Heat but authentic jalapeno flavor. Large, 4.5-5" fruit. Harvest at 65 days green and 85 days red. Medium plants with good yield.



Pepper 'El Jefe'

67/90 days

Jalapeno type. 3.5-4" hot green fruit on large plants. Good disease resistance. Harvest at 67 days green and 90 days red.



Pepper 'Prism'

65/80 days

Midi bell pepper. Early maturing plant is highly productive and produces green, orange and red mid-sized fruit for a multi-colored mix on each plant. Resistance to bacterial leaf spot.



Pepper 'Roulette'

70/90 days

Habanero pepper with the traditional aromatics but almost none of the heat. Mild, citrusy and smokey flavor. Large, sturdy plants produce high yields of 3-3 1/2" fruit. All American Selection.



Pepper 'Round of Hungary' 55 days

Pimento cheese pepper. Ribbed, flattened shape with very thick, sweet skin. 2-2.5" x 3-3.5". Ripens earlier than most. Harvest at 55 days green and 75 red. Good for stuffing, cooking or salads. Organic source



Pepper 'Trident'

64/80 days

Poblano/ Ancho type. Mildly pungent, triangular red, extra-large fruit. 3.5" x 6.5". Medium heat with sweet flavor. Tapered shape. Harvest at 64 days green and 80 days red. Excellent for grilling and stuffing.
