Group 2 – Pruning is moderate or optional. Even though some cultivars can flower on new growth, these Clematis usually produce the largest flowers on older vines from prior years. In spring, prune to remove ends that are damaged or showing no signs of new growth. Use caution to retain stems from last season for best flowering. Group 2 Clematis are repeat bloomers that bloom in late spring/early summer and then sporadically throughout the summer and fall.

‘Asao’

Z. 4-10

6-8” pale, rosy carmine pink flowers. Blooms May-June, September. 6-9’. Z 4. Shade tolerant.



‘Bees Jubilee’

Z. 4-8

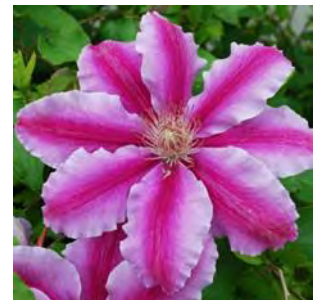
8" mauve-pink flower with carmine bar. Blooms May-June, September. 6-10’ tall, zone 4-8.



‘Dr. Ruppel’

Z. 4-8

6-8" rose red with carmine bar flowers in May, June and September. Grows 6-10' tall.



‘Gillian Blades’

7-9" pure white blooms with frilled edges. Blooms May-June, Sept. 6-8' tall.



‘Guernsey Cream’

6-8" creamy white blooms. May-June, August. 6-9' tall.



‘H.F. Young’

Z. 4-9

6-9", pale blue flowers with white stamens. Blooms in May, June and September. Grows 6'-9' tall.



‘Mrs. N. Thompson’

Z. 3-8

4-6" deep violet purple with a bright red bar. Compact habit. Blooms May-June, September. 6-9' tall.



‘Nelly Moser’

Z. 4-8

Over 100 years in production and still one of the most popular varieties. 7-9" pale mauve-pink with carmine bar flowers in May, June and September. Grows 6-9' tall.



‘Pink Champagne’

Z. 4-8

6-8” purple-pink flowers with light pink central bar. Blooms May-June, September. 6-9’ tall.



‘Princess Kate’

Z. 4-9

Upward, trumpet shaped white flowers with scarlet throats. Blooms summer and into autumn. Grows 5-9’ tall.



‘Red Star’

Z. 4-8

Originally from Japan, this variety has deep magenta 4-5" double flowers. Though its name implies that flowers are red, most people would describe the color as magenta. Blooms May – October. Grows 6-9’ tall.



‘Serenata’

Z. 4-9

4-6" dusky purple flowers with bright yellow stamens. Blooms from June to September. Grows 8-12’ tall.



‘Vancouver Deborah Dahl’

Z. 4-8

7-9” Blooms. Intense red stamens contrast with deep lavender tepals. Blooms May-June, September. 6-9’ tall.



‘Vancouver Sea Breeze’

Z. 4-9

Long bloom time with wavy, 6-8” lavender flowers lasting from spring into fall. Very floriferous cultivar. 5-8’ tall.



‘Westerplatte’

Z. 4-8

Crimson red, 4-6” flowers with reddish stamens. Blooms from June-September. 6-8’ tall, Sun/Partial Shade.



Group 3 – Prune hard. These Clematis are vigorous and bloom primarily on new vines. They bloom in late summer or early fall. Prune the plants every spring down to just above the lowest node showing growth. Large, established plants can also be pruned flat to the soil, which helps initiate new stems.

‘Arabella’

Z. 4-10

Small-flowered, non-vining with open-faced deep blue-mauve blooms in May-October. 3-5’ tall.



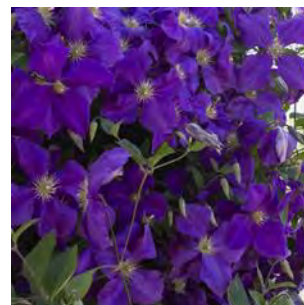
‘Jackmanii’

Z. 4-8

Best known clematis. Easy-to-grow variety. 4-6” deep purple blossoms in June-September. 12-20’ tall.



‘Jackmanii Superba’ Z. 4-8 Similar to the more popular ‘Jackmanii’, but with a smaller flower, improved branching and excellent disease resistance. 4-6” flowers from mid-June to September. Grows 12-20’ tall.



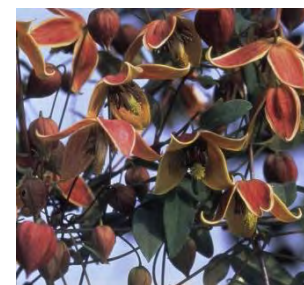
***C. integrifolia* ‘Mongolian Bells’** Z. 3-9 Mounding, herbaceous clematis, with small, bell-shaped blooms in a mix of pink, white, lavender, and blue. Excellent in the xeriscape. Blooms spring-summer. 10-16” tall.



C. paniculata Z. 4-9 **(Sweet Autumn Clematis)** The 1-2” scented flowers and produced in September and October. Grows 20 to 30’ tall.



***C. tangutica* ‘My Angel’** Z. 4-8 The most commonly grown of the yellow-flowered species. The 1-2” nodding flowers are produced from June to September, followed by attractive seed heads which remain on the plant throughout most of the winter.



‘Niobe’ Z. 4-9 Very dark ruby-red 4-6” flowers with yellow stamens. The compact 6-8’ plants, flower from June to September.



‘Rouge (red) Cardinal’

Z. 4-9

Glowing burgundy-crimson with brown stamens. 4-6” blooms from June to September. Mature height 8-12’.
