

# CLEMATIS

## 2026



Vining clematis are perfect for arbors, pergolas, and fences. They thrive in full sun with cool roots—shade the base with rocks, garden accents, or companion plants. All of our clematis are selected to be hardy in Connecticut.

Clematis wilt is common in our area and can cause sudden stem collapse, especially in hot, humid summers. The roots are usually unaffected—simply remove damaged growth and maintain good sanitation, and plants typically regrow. Preventative treatments such as Infuse® granules can help.

## Group 2 - Pruning Moderate or Optional

Bloom on old wood (late spring/early summer) and often rebloom later. Prune lightly in early spring, keeping healthy older stems

### 'Asao'



6-8" pale rosy pink; May-June & September; 6-9'; shade tolerant.

### 'Countess of Lovelace'



6-8" lilac; double in May-June, single in August; 6-9'.

### 'Dr. Ruppel'



6-8" rose-red with carmine bar; May, June & September; 6-10'.

### 'Duchess of Edinburgh'



6" pure white double; May-June; 10-12'.

## 'Ernest Markham'



Large magenta-red; July-September; vigorous; 6-10'. One of the best reds!

## 'Henryi'



6-8" white with brown stamens; May-June; 10-15'. One of the oldest and most popular whites.

## 'John Paul II'



6" cream to light pink with darker stripe; May, June & September; 8-12'. Very vigorous and showy.

## 'Kilian Donahue'



Pink-lavender deepening to fuchsia-red; early and repeat bloomer; 9-10'.

## 'Multi Blue'



4-6" double lavender-blue; June-September; 6-9'.

## 'Nelly Moser'



Over 100 years in production and still one of the most popular varieties. 7-9" pale mauve-pink with carmine bar; May, June & September; 6-9'.

## 'Pink Champagne'



6-8" purple-pink; early and repeat bloomer; May, June and September. 6-9'.

## 'The President'



A favorite for more than a century; 6-8" purple-blue; June-September; 8-12'; blooms on old & new wood.

### 'Vancouver Mystic Gem'



6-8" pink with white edges;  
June-July & September; 6-9'.

### 'Vancouver Sea Breeze'



6-8" pale lavender; long  
bloom season lasting from  
spring into fall; very  
floriferous; 5-8'.

## Group 3 - Hard Prune

Group 3 clematis are vigorous and bloom on new wood in summer to early fall. Cut back in early spring to just above the lowest strong buds (even to the ground on established plants).

### 'Comtesse de Bouchard'



'Tried and true summer-  
bloomer. 4-6" soft pink; June-  
September; 8-12'.

### 'Jackmanii'



Classic deep purple; June-  
September; 12-20'; easy to  
grow.

### 'Jackmanii Superba'



Large dark purple; June-  
September; 12'; excellent  
disease resistance.

### 'Niobe'



4-6" deep ruby-red; June-  
September; 6-8'.

## 'Red Cardinal' (Rouge Cardinal)



Glowing burgundy-crimson blooms with brown stamens; 4-6" flowers from June to September. Grows 8-12' tall.

## 'C. tangutica



Golden, bell-shaped blooms followed by fluffy seedheads. Flowers June to September/October. Can reach 15' tall.

## 'C. virginiana (virgin's Bower, woodbine)



A native clematis with clouds of small white flowers in mid- to late summer; a vigorous climber and host plant for the Clematis Clearwing Moth; 12-20'.

## C. viticella venosa violacea



4-6" white flowers with bold purple veining. Blooms June to September on a 9-12' vine. Sun to partial shade.
