Garden Peonies

Garden peonies are herbaceous perennials that bloom in late spring to early summer. Flowers may be single, semi-double, double, or anemone form. Plant in full to part sun in rich, well-drained, neutral soil. Do not plant crowns deeper than 2", cold dormancy is required for bloom. Large flowers may need staking. Peonies do not like hot, humid weather and may experience some blackening of leaves. Cut diseased leaves off as summer progresses, and cut plants back to ground each fall. Hardy Zones 4-7.

'Alexander Fleming'



Cross of 'Sarah Bernhardt' x 'Bunker Hill'. Double blooms two shades deeper than 'Sarah Bernhardt'. Intensely fragrant.

'Bunker Hill'



Bright fuchsia blooms. Excellent cut flower. Introduced in 1906. Late season. Grows to 33".

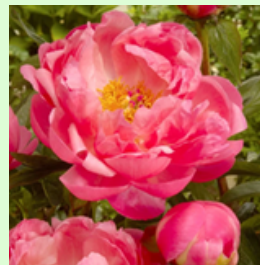
'Claire de Lune'

NEW 2026



Light creamy-yellow single blooms with bright yellow filaments. Stiff stems to 28". Lightly scented. Very early.

'Coral Charm'



American Peony Society Gold Medal winner. Fragrant coral semi-double with dark green foliage. Early bloomer. 47".

'Coral Sunset'



American Peony Society Gold Medal (2003). Hybridized in 1965. Double deep coral blooms; strong stems. Early, vigorous, fragrant. 34" tall. Sister seedling of 'Coral Charm.'

'Duchess de Nemours'



Fragrant double white blooms. Early season. Strong stems. Royal Horticultural Society Award of Garden Merit. 24-36".

'Karl Rosenfeld'



Double red-magenta flowers on red stems with dark foliage. Gold Medal winner. Sturdy stems. Blooms early to mid season. 35".

'Laura Dessert'



Anemone type blossom. Pale pink buds open cream to white with creamy center. Upright habit, good foliage. Blooms early midseason.

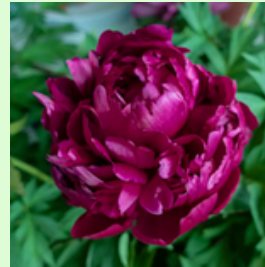
'Paula Fay'



Deep pink blooms with bright yellow stamens. One of the earliest peonies to flower. Sweet fragrance. Excellent cut flower. 31".

Double deep red 6" blooms maturing to a purple-red. Fragrant heirloom. Midseason. 36".

'Pink Hawaiian Coral'



Early season. Semi-double to double 5-6" coral pink and rose blooms with yellow stamens. Strong stems to 36". American Peony Society Gold Medal & Landscape Merit Award.

'Purple Spider'

NEW 2026



Mid - late season. 32". Pink-edged purple-magenta guard petals with spiky fuchsia petaloids. Excellent cut flower.

'Red Charm'



Large burgundy-red double blooms with light berry scent. Early bloomer. 33".

'Sarah Bernhardt'



Fully-petaled pink blooms. Late season. Fragrant. May require staking. One of the most-loved peonies. Grows to 3'.

'Shirley Temple'



Light rose-pink fading to white. Exceptionally large 8" blossoms. Very early. Strong stems. Sweet, spicy fragrance.

'Sorbet'



Fully double with fluffy pink and cream petals. Midseason. 25-35".

Itoh Peonies

Itoh peonies are hybrids of tree and herbaceous peonies with large blooms and sturdy stems. They bloom later and longer than common garden peonies. Leave stems in place; remove dead leaves in fall.

'Bartzella'



Double, lemon-yellow blooms with red-orange streaks in the center. Heavy flowering. To 32".

'Cora Louise'



Very large semi-double white blooms with purple-pink centers and yellow stamens. Mid-late season. Strong stems.

'First Arrival'



6-8" semi-double to double lavender-pink blooms with dark flares and orange-yellow stamens. Abundant flowers on sturdy stems. See it in our Ginkgo Garden!

'Garden Treasure'



Extra-large 6-8" bright yellow semi-double blooms. Lemon scented. Vigorous, sturdy plants to 27". No staking needed. Foliage remains healthy long into the summer.

'Julia Rose'



6-8" semi-double blooms open strawberry red, fading to apricot-yellow with plummy tips. 28" tall. Spicy fragrance.

'Old Rose Dandy'



Mid-late season. Purplish-rose blooms fade to orange-yellow with red flares at the base. Semi-double 4-5" flowers. 2-3' tall.

'Pastel Splendor'

NEW 2026



Midseason. Lightly fragrant single blooms in pink-lavender with deep red bases and creamy centers. Vigorous. 30".

'Scarlet Heaven'



Huge dark red blooms with yellow centers on sturdy stems. Mature plants can produce 50+ flowers.
